# OUR PERFORMANCE

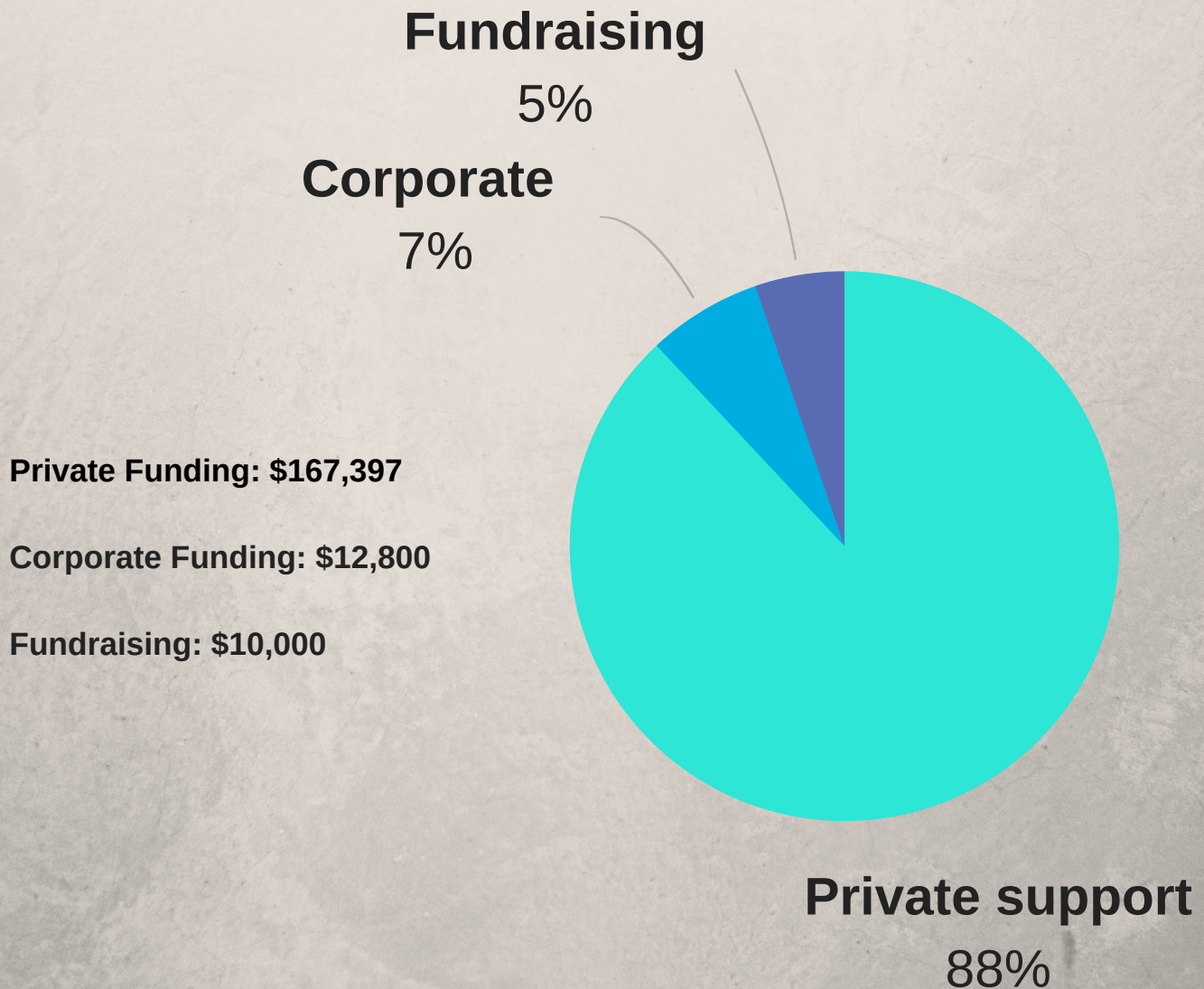
