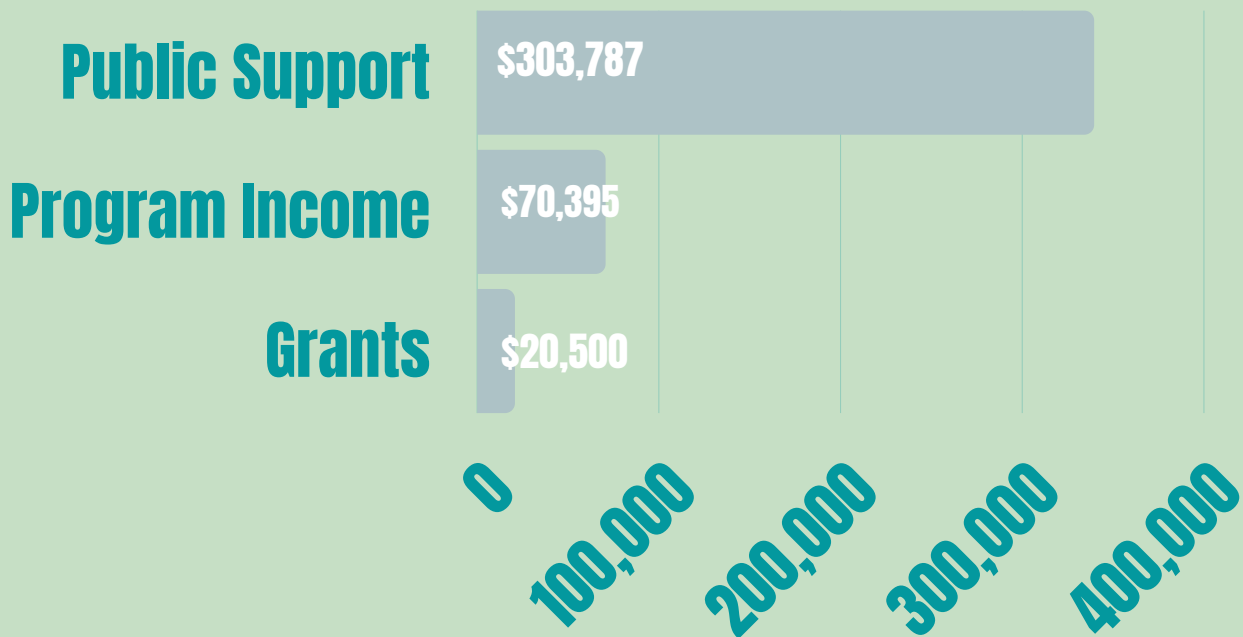

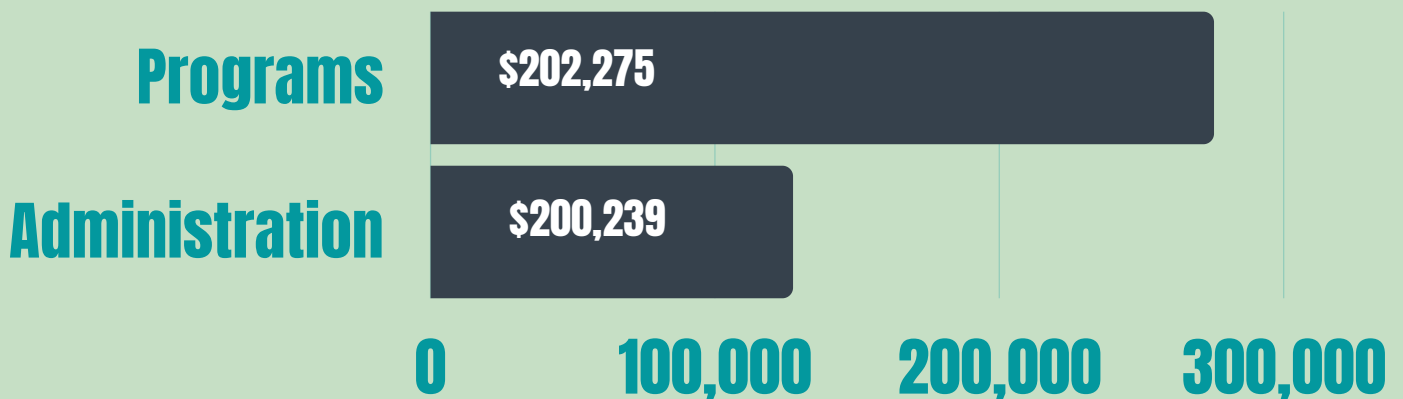

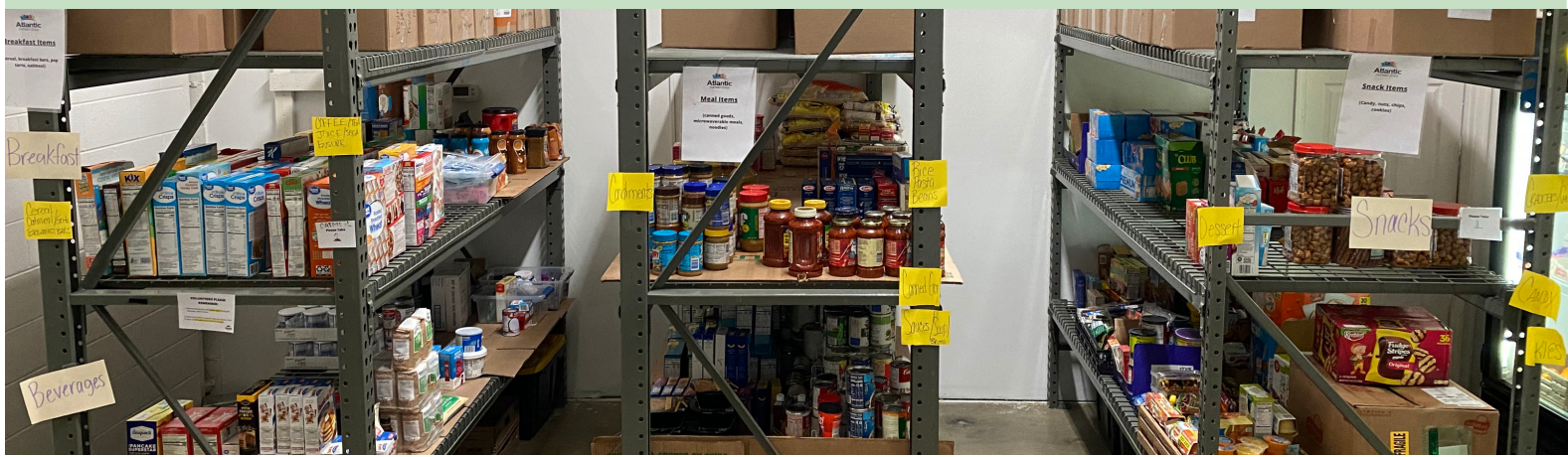

Impact: Food Pantry



Our food pantry increased our food distribution by **81%** in 2021!

In 2021, our pantry provided food assistance to 24,256 individuals and 20,120 families. We were also excited to obtain a box truck to assist us in reaching our goal of serving 1,000 individuals each week.



Our food pantry program offers our communities three ways to access food resources:

- Weekly mobile food pantry
- Weekly food box pick-ups
- Deliveries

Impact: Fresh Start

Fresh Start is a transitional housing program designed to help homeless individuals who are experiencing mental health and substance use barriers transition to self-sufficient living. Through our collaborative partnerships we are able to offer wrap-around services and resources to truly prepare participants for a fresh start at life.

Fresh Start is designed to support the needs of those we serve based on a person centered approach. Fresh Start meets everyone where they are we work together to create a success plan that includes a combination of the following :

"8 to Great" Empowerment Program: Each individual can participate in this program that offers eight key components to lead to a life of self sufficiency. Participants complete tailored modules based on their needs assessment. Individuals completing the "8 to Great" Empowerment Program are eligible to receive financial assistance to secure housing upon discharge.

Holiday Helping Hands

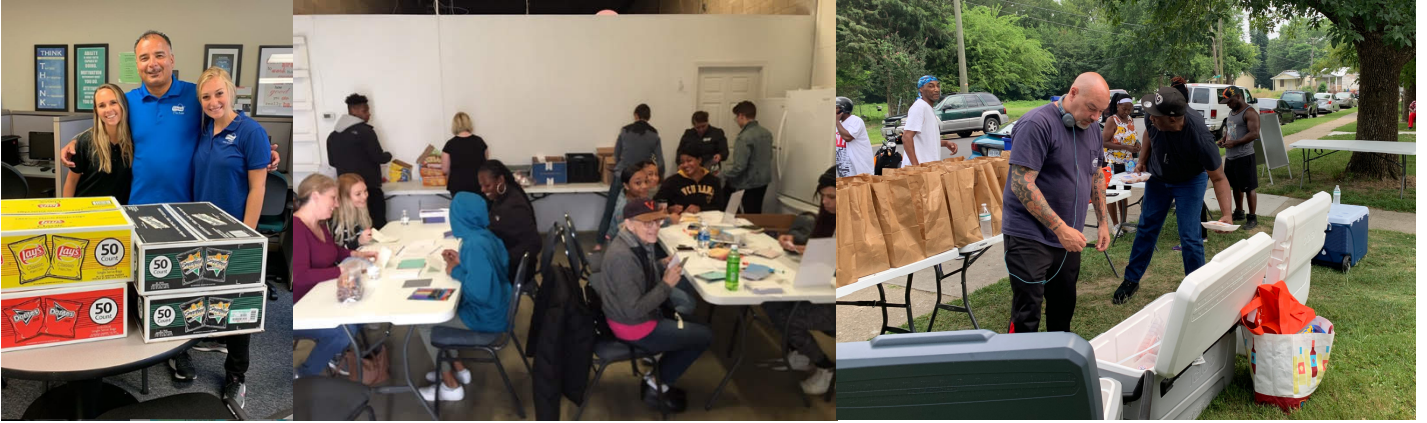
